## Why six minutes?

- 60 divided by 6 =

#### Tennessee

- Felonies: No time limit for murder or crimes punishable by death or life imprisonment; 15 years for Class A offenses; eight years for Class B offenses or arson; six years for defrauding the state, evading or failing to pay taxes, or fraudulent tax returns; four years for Class C or D offenses; two years for Class E offenses; three years for other unspecified offenses; when the child reaches 21 years of age for sex crimes against a child
- Misdemeanors: One year for general misdemeanors; six months for offenses relating to gaming
- Code section: <u>40-2-101</u>
- When statute tolls: The clock does not run while the suspect resides outside the state or while the crime is being concealed; in certain offenses where the victim is a child, the statute begins running when the child turns 18 years old



Billing Method








## Are paralegals licensed?

## How much to charge per hour for 20% profit?

$$Bill Rate = \frac{Cost}{Capacity \times Utilization Goal} + Profit Goal$$

$$Bill Rate = \frac{\$80,000 + \$20,000 + \$50,000}{2080 \times 58\%} + \$31 = \$155$$

## Personal Injury Lawyer's Story

- Personally, I work completely on commission. Most of my clients would not be able to hire an attorney if they had to pay by the hour.
- If we settle a case pre-litigation, then the firm takes 1/3 of the recovery.
- If I must file a lawsuit then whether, by settlement or verdict, we take 40%.
- In either case, we also collect our out-of-pocket expenses. Of that, I
  personally have a contract for 25% of whatever the firm brings in.



## Personal Injury Lawyer's Story

- Some lawyers at my firm have different contracts for varying percentages because of their skill level.
- In all cases, when we hire a new lawyer, we put them on salary for a year but at any time they can decide to move to commission if it's in their best interest.
- In contrast, most of the lawyers I work opposite of (lawyers that work for corporations or insurance companies) are paid by the hour.
